Planning Meeting Special

Issue No. 59 - November 2012

This is just a quick update with brief details of the Planning Meeting yesterday. More will follow in a full FolkMog News next month.

FolkMog Chairman, Maurice Cook, opened the meeting, last year's minutes were agreed, and the past year's events reviewed. Twenty events had been held, with 11 different organisers and attended by a total of 457 people.

Officers' Reports

The Treasurer, Roger Coverley, reported that our finances are in good shape with £568 in the bank.

Roger Tatton said that it would be his turn to stand down from the committee at next year's Planning Meeting and that a new committee member would then be needed to take on FolkMog News.

Alan Biddlecombe reported that the new website was working well and he has plans for further improvements. He will continue to look after the website.

2013 Events

An outline plan for the next year was discussed. Twenty replies had been received to the FolkMog questionnaire, the results of which will be considered by the committee in January. The following dates were agreed:

January 27th	NTCL, St Peter's Hall near Bungay
February 17th	Lunch, White Horse, Stoke Ash, on the A140 south of Scole
March 24th	Treasure Hunt, Weston Longville, Norfolk
April 27th	Ipswich Transport Museum + lunch
June 20th -24th	Long weekend, Bristol area
August 4th	Helmingham Hall Festival of Classic & Sportscars (with Anglemog)

The Gymkhana will be in early July at the location planned for 2012, hopefully with better weather!

In future the Planning Meeting will be held in October, rather than November, giving a longer gap between it and NTCL, two of our major events which are rather close together. It will also remove any potential clash with Remembrance Sunday.

Election of Officers

Alan Biddlecombe stood down as Centre Secretary after his three years of tenure; Ian Charity was elected as the new centre Secretary. Alan now becomes Centre Chairman, replacing Maurice Cook.

David Corbett was elected as a new member of the committee, also replacing Alan.


Alan Braithwaite, already a committee member will take over from Diana as Events Co-ordinator.


